South Central CIT Council   Fort Leonard Wood CIT Training Summary Mike Sherman, Gregg McBride, Kelly Beisser	On June 5-9, 2023, the South Central CIT Council provided a 40-hour Crisis Intervention Team (CIT) training at Fort Leonard Wood to 21 soldiers and Department of the Army (DA) civilians, including fire department personnel, Criminal Investigation Division (CID) agents, Military Police (MP) officers, DA Police officers, corrections officers, and mental health personnel. The training was well received with a few modifications suggested to focus on military culture. Information about the training was provided to the Pentagon and	The evaluations were positive. 
	DA, who were extremely receptive to the content taught and the reactions of the soldiers who attended. It was so well received that the DA is planning on instituting 'the Missouri Model' of CIT Training in four more states. This CIT Training will be the first in the nation, eventually instituting CIT throughout all of the Army bases around the world. The overarching goal is to establish a crisis response team on each Army base that will help reduce stigma and burnout in troops at all levels.	The next training is scheduled for August 28 <sup>th</sup> to September 1, 2023, at Fort Leonard Wood, with four subsequent CIT trainings scheduled.

[Jefferson City, MO] The Crisis Intervention Team (CIT) Missouri Council has named a new Coordinator for the state, Sergeant Ashley McCunniff, supervisor of the CIT Unit at the Kansas City Police Department (KCPD), has agreed to take on this role. The MO Council is confident that CIT will continue to expand and thrive under her leadership.

The purpose of CIT is to address the challenges that often arise when law enforcement officers encounter individuals with behavioral health conditions in crisis situations.

Sgt. McCunnilT's new coordinator position was announced at a recent CTT statewide meeting. The CTT MO Council appreciates the support of the Department of Mental Health (DMH), the Missouri Beahvioral Health Council, the KCPP and the McCunnilT Family.

McCunniff replaces Sheriff Jason Klaux who served for more than five years as the MO CIT Coordinator. He was recently appointed Perry County Sheriff. Sheriff Klaux' exceptional involvement, dedication, and support for the wellness of limit reponders made MO CIT a national leader. He will remain involved in the MO CIT as the Southeast Missouri Regional CIT Coordinator.
