

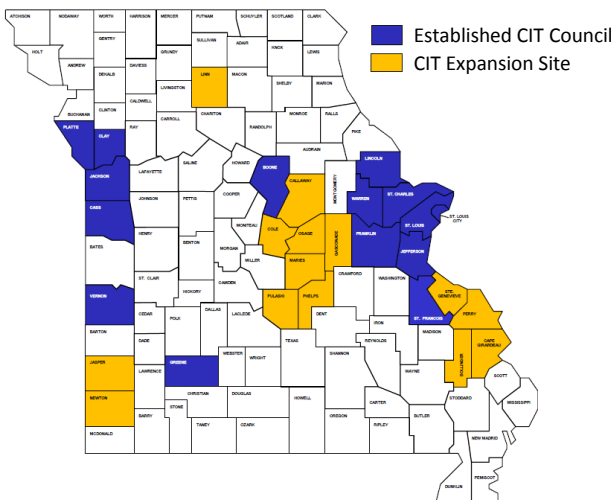

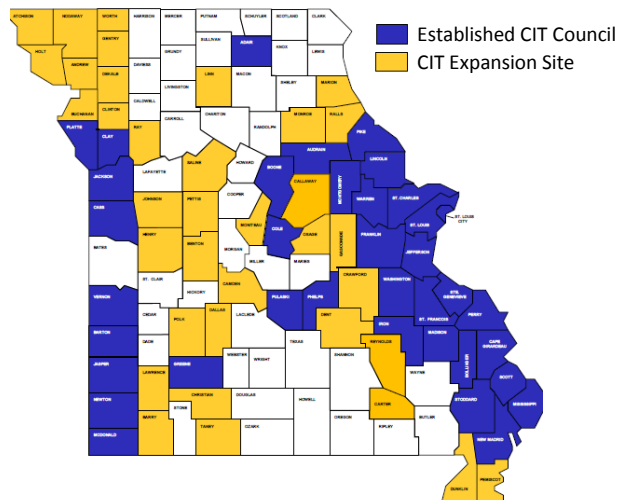
Missouri CIT Council Support

- ✓ Hired a CIT law enforcement officer as the State CIT Coordinator to promote and expand CIT statewide.
- ✓ Host an annual MO CIT Conference for law enforcement and behavioral health providers.
 - ★ Conference attendance | 2015 = 350 | 2016 = 450 | 2017 = 500
- ✓ Developed and maintain the Missouri CIT website.
- ✓ Promote CIT at other law enforcement statewide conferences.
- ✓ Support expansion of CIT in Missouri.

- ✓ Revised the Missouri CIT curriculum with POST approved course content.
- ✓ Promote Mental Health First Aid training for Public Safety.
- ✓ Host bi-monthly CIT Council meetings in Jefferson City.
